2020-21 General Supply Recommendations for All Grades

Revised 5/7/2020

Here teachers have provided their recommendations of supplies that they believe will best keep students organized during the school year. **The following, while not required, represent examples of what is useful: no particular brand is required to be purchased.** Families may work from this list, or they may find the system that best works for their student and keeps them organized.

Binders

At least one 3-ring binder to organize papers, handouts, and assignments.

- Most students prefer for have 2-3 binders, with each beind devoted to the work for 2-3 classes.

- Most students prefer 1.5 - 2 inch binders.

- Package of 6 tab section dividers - for placing in 3 ring binders.

- 3 hole punch for classwork needing to be added to binders

- Binders must be free of pop culture depictions, sports teams, logos, messages, etc.

Paper

A constant supply of loose-leaf paper to complete assignments and take notes

College ruled or wide rulled paper is acceptable.

Students may also use spiral-bound notebooks to take notes for classes. Must be able to remove ragged edges when torn out.

Most students prefer to have 1 "single-subject" notebook per class to keep their notes organized.

Writing Utensils

Pencil case for carrying supplies between classes.

4 sharpened #2 pencils (mechanical pencils are permitted).

Students are encouraged to have personal pencil sharpener with a shavings collector as well to keep their pencils sharpened throughout the day.

Erasers

Highlighters

Blue, red and black pens

Dry-erase markers & eraser

Other Supplies

USB Flash drive

Scissors

Rigid ruler (Reccommended: transparent plastic)

Student planner for keeping track of assignment and test dates. Planners are not provided by the school.

Locker shelf, many students find that using a locker shelf helps keep their lockers organized and makes better use of the locker space.

Small stapler and staples

Students will engage in project work in some classes that require materials such as poster board, glue sticks, colored paper, colored pencils, markers, etc. While students will be given ample notice and time for work on these assignments, some families find it helpful to have such items "on hand."
