

SPIRIT WEEK IS COMING TO TRIVIUM PREP!

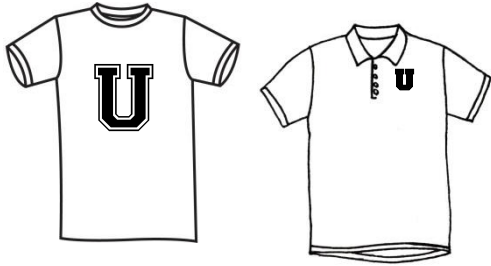
Monday, September 12 – Friday, September 16

Spirit Wear outerwear will be permitted to be worn in class during Spirit Week, along with College/Sports outerwear on themed days. A t-shirt must be worn under sports jerseys. Students who wear offensive/inappropriate items will need to change or be sent home.
