Here teachers have provided their recommendations of supplies they believe will best keep students organized during the school year. **The following, while not required, represent examples of what is useful: no particular brand is required to be purchased.** Families may work from this list, or they may find the system that best works for their student and keeps them organized.

General Supplies
<b>6- one inch three-ring binder (one for each class). This is to organize papers, handouts, and assignments. Binders must be free of pop culture depictions, sports teams, logos, messages, etc.</b>
Package of 6 tab section dividers - for placing in 3 ring binders.
<b>3+ packs of loose-leaf paper.</b> College ruled or wide ruled paper is acceptable.
Students may also use spiral-bound notebooks
Pencil case for carrying supplies between classes.
4 packs of sharpened #2 pencils or mechanical pencils
Erasers
Highlighters
400- 3x5 index note Cards (white only)
4-red pens
Blue and Black pens
4 Dry-erase markers & eraser
Rigid Ruler, plastic and transparent
Locker shelf
Scissors
Backpack without wheels (free of pop culture)
Lunch Box (free of pop culture)
Water Bottle (free of pop culture)
Wired ear buds
