### \*\*Seniors who have not signed up have until this Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Go to the Trivium Configio site to sign up and pay deposit.

Please be aware of the following conditions that will put your senior trip eligibility under review by the Headmaster:

- 1. Any failed class your Senior year.
- 2. Any grade that is deficient within two weeks of the Senior Trip.
- **3.** Any Senior Thesis essay that is not turned in on time and approved.
- 4. Any In-school Suspension or Out-of-school Suspension during Senior year.
- 5. Any Senior not on track to graduate.

There are **<u>NO REFUNDS after September 1<sup>st</sup></u>** if you have paid and your student is not allowed to attend the senior trip because they do not meet these eligibility requirements.

- Great Hearts is offering the opportunity to take CLEP & AP Exams this coming spring.

# **Application Deadlines**

- The <u>senior valedictorian</u> is the recipient of the highest honor that the Academy can confer upon a student. The valedictorian is selected at the beginning of May by the assembled faculty.
- <u>Academic GPA</u> through the senior year among students who have been at the school since at least the beginning of 10th grade is the primary criterion for selecting the valedictorian.
- <u>Personal conduct and positive participation in the school's culture and</u> <u>activities are also considered</u>; negative facts (such as a serious act of misconduct, especially academic dishonesty, at any point in a student's record) may be considered as disqualifying.
- <u>The faculty reserves the right to not award the top academic student if</u> <u>the faculty determines that another high-level academic student stands as</u> <u>a considerably better character example to the community.</u>
- It is possible for co-valedictorians to be selected. The faculty may also select a salutatorian from the senior class, a student of high distinction beneath the valedictorian.
