## **General Supplies**

**6 one inch three-ring binder** (one for each class). This is to organize papers, handouts, and assignments. Binders must be free of pop culture depictions, sports teams, logos, messages, etc.

6 tab section dividers (for placing in 3 ring binders)

3+ packs of loose-leaf paper. College ruled or wide ruled paper is acceptable.

Students may also use spiral-bound notebooks

Handheld pencil case (for carrying supplies between classes)

4 packs of sharpened #2 pencils or mechanical pencils

Blue, black, and red pens - 4 of each color
