1 inch three-ring binders (3 at minimum to share between classes to organize papers, handouts, and assignments. Binders must be free of pop culture depictions, sports teams, logos, messages, etc.)
6 tab section dividers (for placing in 3 ring binders)
3+ packs of loose-leaf paper. College ruled or wide ruled paper is acceptable.
Students may also use spiral-bound notebooks
Handheld pencil case (for carrying supplies between classes)
4 packs of sharpened #2 pencils or mechanical pencils

3x5 Index note cards (white only) - 500 count
Blue, black, and red pens - 4 of each color
4 Dry-erase markers & eraser
Plastic and transparent rigid ruler
Locker shelf (helps with organization)
Scissors

Backpack without wheels (free of pop culture)
Lunch Box (free of pop culture)
